HUNTER'S PISTOL

SMALLBORE HUNTER'S PISTOL

SMALLBORE COWBOY RIFLE

WHAT: NRA Approved competition in Hunter's Pistol and Smallbore Hunter's Pistol Silhouette, with separate categories for open sights; NRA Approved competition in Smallbore Cowboy Rifle Silhouette.

WHERE: Durham County Wildlife Club, 3616 Hopson Rd, Morrisville, NC. Two miles from I-40 & Davis Drive, Research Triangle Park, North Carolina. (Between Raleigh and Durham)

WHO: Competition is open to all. Juniors under the age of 21 may discharge firearms only while under the direct supervision of their parent or legal guardian.

WHEN: 2011 Matches are scheduled (rain or shine) for the 3rd Sunday of the month except April which is on the 2nd Sunday.

Range will be open by 10:00 AM for sighting/practice. **Match starts 11:00 AM.**

Pistols and Cowboy Rifle

COURSE: 10 Shots at Chickens @ 40 yards;
OF 10 Shots at Pigs @ 50 yards;
FIRE 10 Shots at Turkeys @ 75 yards;
10 Shots at Rams @100 yards;

Each stage is fired in two 5-shot strings, with 2 minutes per string for the pistols and cowboy rifle. Targets are engaged left to right, with one shot being fired at each animal. Scoring is "X" (animal knocked over), or "O" (animal remains standing).

Targets are reset by the shooters or scorers after each 10 shot string. **Current NRA Silhouette Rules will apply.**

GUN: See current NRA Pistol and/or Rifle Silhouette Rules for detailed descriptions.

SPOTTING: See current NRA Pistol and/or Rifle Silhouette Rules for detailed descriptions.

POSITION: See current NRA Pistol and/or Rifle Silhouette Rules for detailed descriptions.

CALIBERS: See current NRA Pistol and/or Rifle Silhouette Rules for detailed descriptions.

NOTE: Eye and ear protection must be worn by everyone on the range, including spectators.

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 for each competition entered. Re-entries (\$5.00) are allowed, but first-time entries have priority.

CLASSES: NRA Silhouette classification will be used. If there are 3 or more unclassified competitors, there will be an unclassified class, otherwise, unclassified shooters will shoot in the highest available class.

MISCELLANEOUS: Rest rooms and drinking water are available on site. Food and lodging is available within a 5 minute drive of the range.

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE: From Raleigh & points east, take I-40 WEST; from Chapel Hill and points west, take I-40 EAST. **Exit at Davis Drive and turn left.** Follow signs to NC 54. Do NOT turn at NC 54 (stay on Davis Drive for another 0.9 mile). Turn right on Hopson Road. Go about 0.8 mile. Sign (Durham County Wildlife Club) & dirt road on the left. The Pistol range is just after the archery range on the right.
